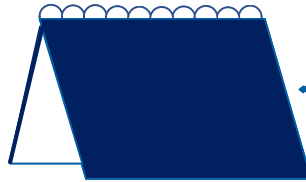

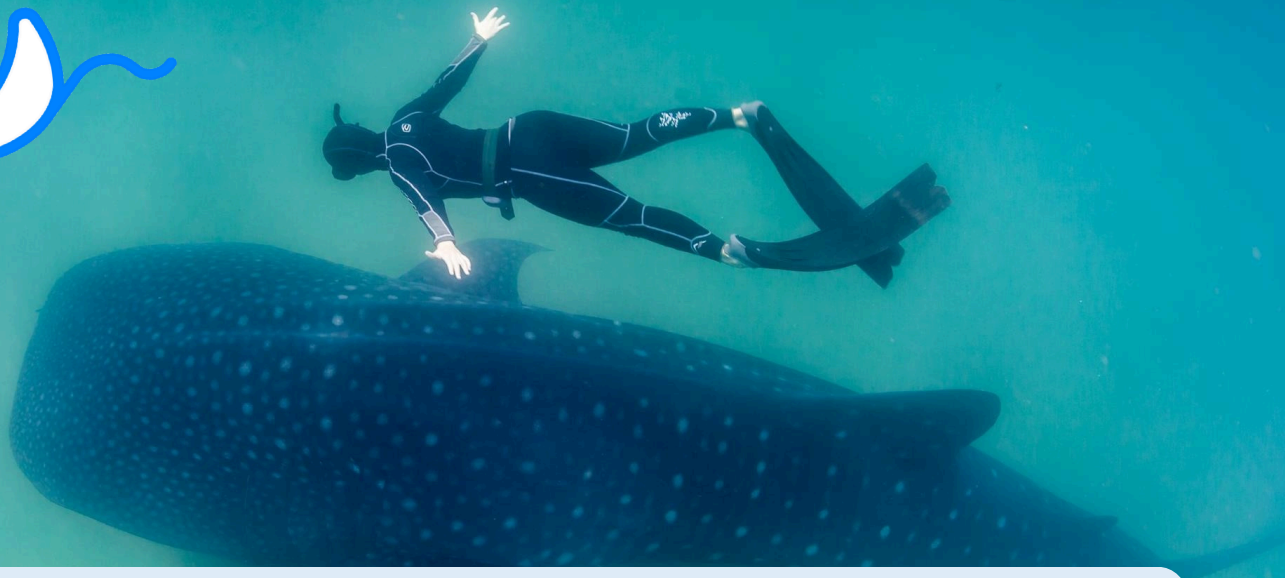

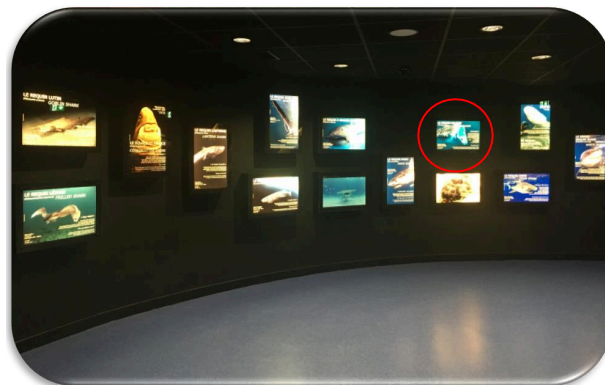
Question :



Search and find... What's this shark's name?

Réponse :

It's the whale shark! It's called like that because it's the largest fish currently living on Earth. It can grow up to 20 m long! (To represent 20 m, invite 2 children to stand side by side and have one of them take 20 big steps forward).



Its secret :

The whale shark eats only zooplankton (animal plankton)!

To go further :

Nausicaá supports the Megaptera association, which studies whale sharks. For several years now, one of Nausicaá's caretakers has been helping to identify whale sharks and to fit tags that enable us to track their movements for 300 days!

Congratulations !

You found some of the animals' secrets of Nausicaa... but there are so many others !

Did you know, for example, that shark scales inspired engineers to create swimsuits, or that crustacean shells have healing properties ?

We still have so much to discover !

Ocean provides us with so many services and resources essential to our life on earth.

It's up to us to take care of it.
