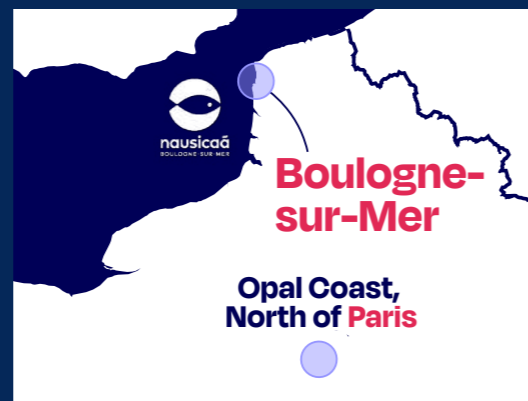


Who are we?

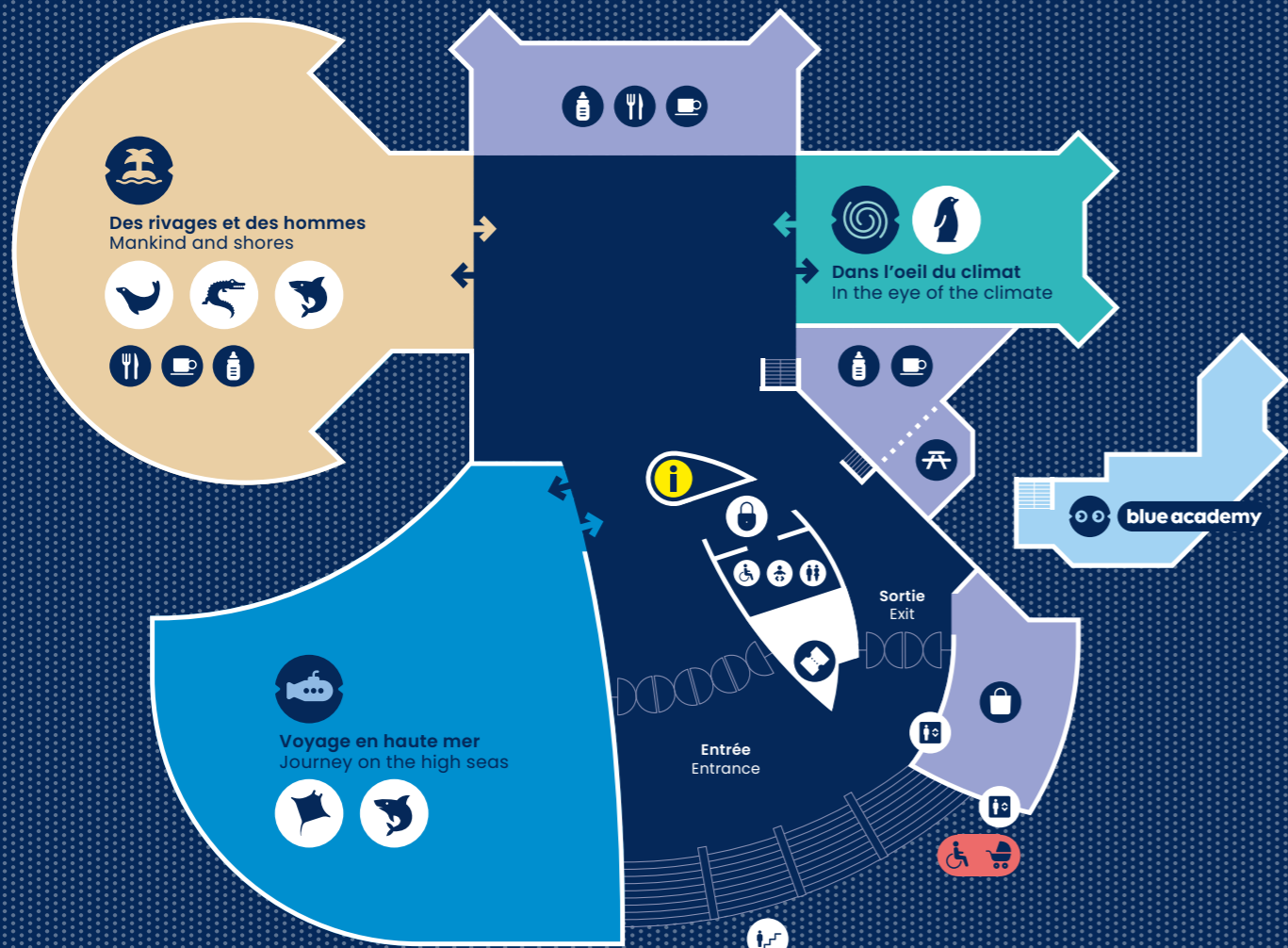

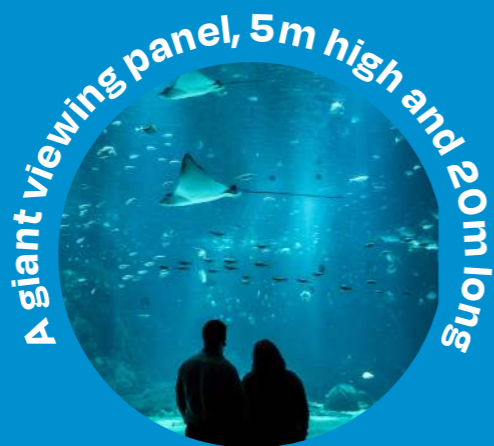
Nausicaá has chosen to put the spotlight on the High Seas, one of the planet's most vast and lesser-known environments. Located more than 500 km off the coast, it makes up nearly half the Earth's surface, yet remains largely unprotected. Inspired by Malpelo, this exhibition sheds light on an ecosystem that is vital to biodiversity, the climate and marine resources. An invitation to learn all about how important this faraway world is, a world that is still all too often overlooked.

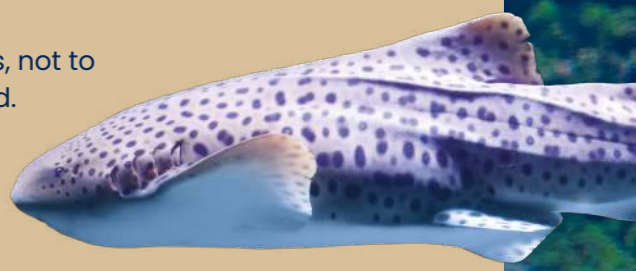


All aboard for your first tour of the world's seas!

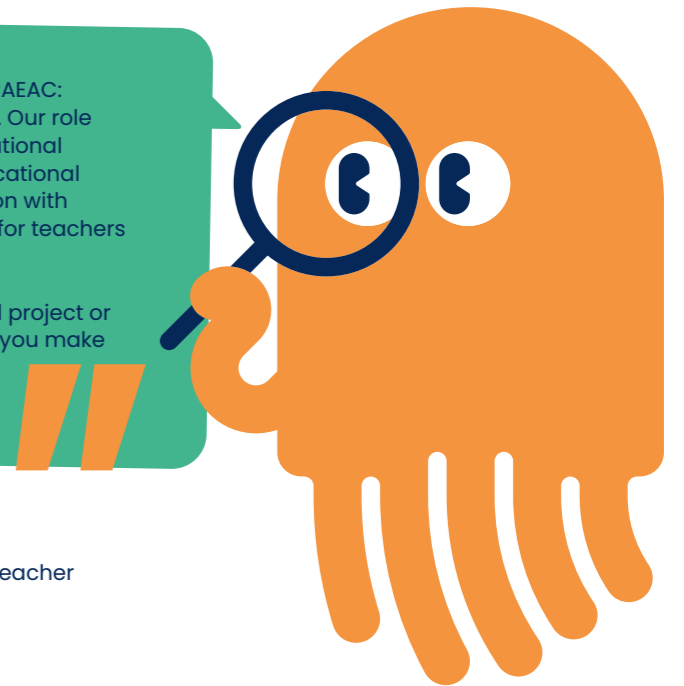
Scientific mediators

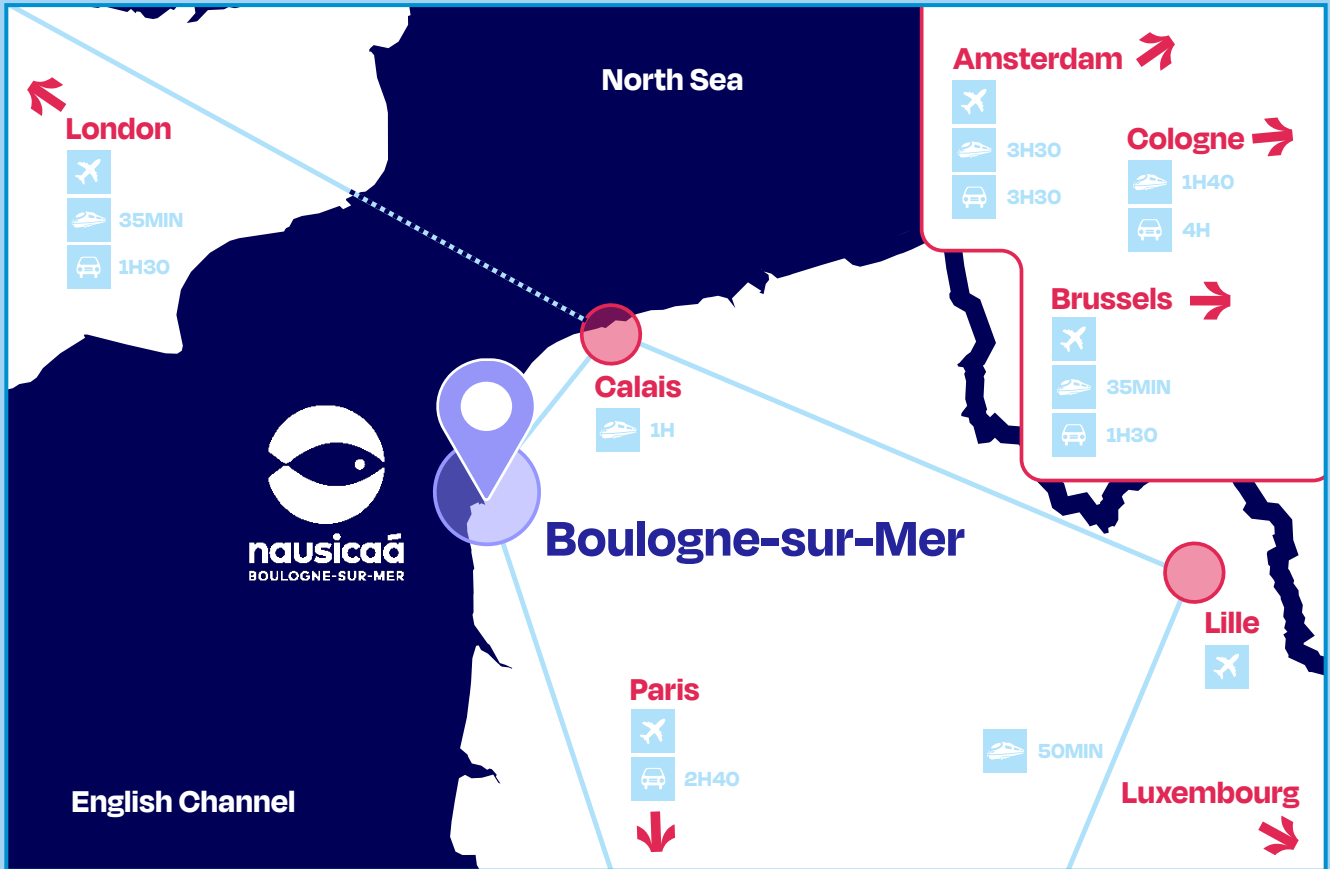
